In recent years Moss has become a huge problem, so Why is Moss such a problem?

Weather you want a traditional lush green lawn, or a wild flower meadow moss will always compete with other plants in its environment.

Our Environment has changed dramatically.

- Wet winters instead of cold and frosty
- Poor drainage
- lack of nutrition
- shade from the sun
- Excessive thatch levels
- Mowing at the correct height

Cutting too short will encourage moss growth.

For the best advice on how and when to mow your lawns ask the Emerald team for advice.

*Fact: Moss plants develop from spores blown in the wind and bedding in the thatch, both which cannot be seen until it develops.*
